Within our selection of wines you will find that we have attempted to include the most popular countries, regions and grape varieties for your enjoyment.


We take considerable pride in our wines and sincerely hope that you take enjoyment choosing and drinking from our selections, and most importantly that you will visit us time after time!

For your convenience, we use the Wine Development Board's Wine Tasting Guide Champagne, White and Rosé wines are designated numbers from 1 to 9, with 1 being the driest and 9 being the sweetest. Red wines are designated letters from A to E, with A being the lightest and softest and E being the deepest and fullest.







1. Baron d'Arignac Colombard Dry France / 2 / £18.95**

A dry wine with aromatic nose of peach and white flowers. Easy drinking as an aperitif or to be enjoyed with seafood.



2. I Castelli Pinot Grigio delle Venezie D.O.C / Italy / 2 / £20.50**

Fresh, delicately spicy with light minerality, balanced and persistent. Good fruity notes and light aromatics.



3. Jarrah Wood Chardonnay Australia / 2 / £20.75

Fresh and well balanced, this fruit driven Chardonnay has plenty of tropical fruit flavours of melons and peach with rich aromas.



4. Healy & Gray Private Cellar Bushvine Chenin Blanc

South Africa / 3 / £21.50**

Aromas of ripe red apple and tropical fruits jump out of the glass. Lovely pineapple and lychee flavours fill the palate.



5. Amatore Garganega Sauvignon Blanc Italy / 1 / £22.25**

A beautiful straw-yellow colour with intense citrus and tropical fruit aromas the Sauvignon Blanc shines through with elegance. SWA Gold Award. SWA

6. Muscadet de Sevre et Maine Sage France / 1 / £25.50

From the Loire Valley, this stunning wine has the alluring aroma of fennel, which gives way to a clean burst of citrus acidity and finishes with a lean freshness.

Perfect with, seafood and salads.



7. Albarino Pepe Rias Baixas Spain / 2 / £30.50

Apple and pear orchard flavours combine with notes of soft and tropical fruit and an underlying minerality to produce a beautifully well-balanced wine.



8. Gavi di Gavi Il Portino Italy / 2 / £31.00

This wine is a wonderful reflection of the Cortese grape variety. It is fruity and aromatic with just a hint of mineral notes and a mouth-watering citrus finish.



9. Waddling Duck Sauvignon Blanc New Zealand / 1 / £35.00

Classic and intense fresh passion fruit and gooseberry aromas. Intense and full.

10. Chablis Victor Berard France / 1 / £35.75

Classic bone dry wine, 100% Chardonnay. Fresh vivacious aromas and a full steely palate. This wine is elegant with great finesse. Perfect with poultry, and cheese dishes.



11. Sancerre Domaine Durand France / 1 / £41.50

This wine is from a small producer who places emphasis on the quality. Flinty and fruity, a wonderful nose, with all the classic flavours that follow. Perfect with seafood dishes



12. Pouilly Fuisse Mommessin Auvigue / France / 1 / £51.50

Jean Auvigue produces Pouilly Fuissé of the highest quality with vibrant Chardonnay fruit. It is rich with mineral flavours while a brief maturation in wooden cask adds spice and complexity.

13. Chablis 1ER Cru Les Vaucopins J Moreau Brochard / France / 1 / £57.00

This stunning wine originates from vineyards situated on long slopes facing the sunrise, which aid quality maturing resulting in a long and rich wine with fruity flavours and those all-important mineral notes.

14. Baron d'Arignac Cabernet Sauvignon France / B / £18.75**

A classic Cabernet Sauvignon, garnet red in colour with rich cassis and eucalyptus aromas followed up with intense blackberry fruit flavours. Matches perfectly with red meats and cheese.



15. Jarrah Wood Shiraz Australia / C / £21.75

This classic Australian Shiraz is packed with ripe cherry and raspberry flavours with a pepper spice finish. Sommelier Wine Awards Commended.



16. Healy & Gray Estate Merlot Reserva Chile / C / £22.25**

Rich and concentrated Chilean Merlot. Bright Ruby colour with plums and cherries on the nose. Elegant and lingering finish. Pairs well with pasta and cheese dishes.



17. Chianti DOCG Celsus Trambusti Italy / C / £23.50

From the Tuscany Region. Bright ruby red colour. Easy drinking with ripe berry aromas and rich cherry flavours on the palate. Suits meats and creamy pasta dishes.



18. La Grupa Malbec Argentina / D / £24.25

An upfront ripe red fruit nose with sweet spice hints that lead into a voluminous structure of cherries and plum, followed by a warming pleasant finish.



19. Faustino Rivero Crianza D.O.Ca Rioja / Spain / C / £25.25

This famous Spanish wine has matured in American oak casks for 12-14 months and has spicy aromas with moderate tannins on the palate.



20. Saint Emilion Reserve Dulong France / C / £32.95

Round & supple on the palate. Great, rich and fleshy structure. Notes of liquorice, with red and black fruit aromas at the end.



21. Barolo DOCG Manfredi Italy / D / £36.75

The famous Barolo wine, of ancient and noble origins, is aged in Slovenian oak barrels and it turns intensely ruby red with a rich elegant bouquet. Best enjoyed with fine red meat and game dishes.



22. Chateauneuf du Pape 38 Parcelles / France / E / £39.00

The Quiot family have been producing wine in the Rhone since 1748. A full-bodied, powerful Chateauneuf with intense aromas of black fruits and a concentrated elegant palate of damsons.

23. Waddling Duck Pinot Noir New Zealand / B / £46.00

The bouquet is rich in fruit flavours of sweet black cherries which harmonies beautifully with the notes of oak. A medium level of soft, ripe tannins provides a silky texture to this lingering, accessible wine. Perfect pairing with dishes of lean meats.



24. Amarone Classico della Valpolicella DOCG Monteci Italy / D / £51.50

From the Veneto Region. Rich and full bodied, deep Ruby Red in colour. A well-structured, balanced wine with notes of currants and wild berries, and a velvety palate. Perfect with game, red meats and ripe cheeses.



25. Fincas de Azabache Gran Reserva D.O.Ca Rioja / Spain / D / £61.50

Clear, ruby red with garnet reflections. Intense aroma, scented with spices, cherry jam and red berry fruit. Very persistent, velvety to broad structure.

26. I Castelli Pinot Grigio Blush Delle Venezie DOC / Italy / 2 / £20.50**

A light, very easy style of wine with a soft, refreshing burst of summer red fruits.



27. Monterey Bay Zinfandel Rose USA / 5 / £23.25**

Quite the most delicious wine, a racy mix of watermelon and cherry with a delectable sweetness



28. Sancerre Rose Saget France / 2 / £39.50

Made from Pinot Noir in the heart of the central vineyards. Beautiful light refreshing style with strawberry flavours that seem to linger forever.

29. Chateau Les Mingets Sauternes France / 9 / £15.95**

A concentrated, luscious dessert wine showing intense flavours of caramelized fruits, pear, melon and almond, rounded and balanced by good acidity.



30. Prosecco Serenello Extra Dry Italy / 2 /

20 CL Btl £8.50** / £26.75**

The delicious aromas of apple and pear melt into a smooth and fresh wine on the palate. Sommelier Wine Awards Gold.



31. Prosecco Rose DOC Serenello Italy / 2 / £30.50**

A lovely rose pink colour, with aromas of petals and fresh strawberries.



Champagne

32. Champagne Castelnau Brut Classique NV / France / 1 / £45.00

Delightful aromas of apricot and white peach. The charm of this Champagne make it a natural temptation anytime. Voted 18th in Drinks International 'Most Admired Champagne Brands 2020'.



33. La Cuvee Laurent-Perrier France / 1 / £55.00

Laurent-Perrier's signature champagne, La Cuvée is delicate yet complex with crisp notes of citrus fruit and white flowers, and great length on the finish.



34. Veuve Clicquot Brut France / 1 / £60.00

A world famous Champagne, rich and creamy in style, with an explosion of citrus fruit and a delightful yeasty toastiness.



35. Bollinger Brut Special Cuvee France / 1 / £75.00

This champagne shows incredible smooth and creamy fruit with an elegance and finesse equalled by very few other Champagnes.



36. Champagne Castelnau Brut Rosé NV France / 1 / £60.00

Notes of sweets and crystallised fruits linger, lifted by a touch of eau-de-vie of cherries from the Pinot Noir as befits a true rose.



37. Cuvee Rose Laurent-Perrier NV France / 1 / £90.00

This iconic rosé Champagne has great depth and freshness with hints of fresh strawberries, raspberries and wild cherries.



38. Dom Perignon France / 1 / £170.00

Stylish and seductive, open and expressive with delicate ripe stone fruit, floral touches and minerality. Beautiful palate, with hints of honey leading to a polished finish and a touch of crisp grapefruit.











Premium Wines

Since opening our restaurant in 2006 we have spent considerable time researching and drinking some very nice wines, whilst looking for ideal accompaniments to the food we offer.

Over the next few pages you will see a selection of some of our favourites that we have been able to source for our customers to enjoy. Sadly, sometimes these are limited quantities as vintages change, being replaced by newer vintages or a new discovery!





39. Pouilly Fume, Chateau Tracy Loire, France / £59.00

A wine growing property for more than 600 years, to the north of Pouilly Fume on the hillsides that overlook the Loire, the Chateau Tracy vineyard extends form 'Tracy Hill' to 'Champs de Cris'..This wine is pale yellow with a golden hue, having intense aromas of white fruits and nectarine which gain complexity when the wine is left to breathe. On the palate is a supple sensation with a richness following through to a persistent and intense finish.

40. St. Aubin 1er Cru, Maison Jaffelin Bourgogne, France / £60.00

The small commune of Saint-Aubin in Cote de Beaune with just 20 Premier cru vineyards, produce this 100% Chardonnay wine from Maison Jaffelin, founded by Charles and Henri Jaffelin. Notes of white flowers, lemon and vanilla with a lovely, crisp and mineral finish.

41. Puligney Montrachet, Domaine Louis Chavy Cote de Beaune, France / £67.50

From newly commissioned and modern cellars this wine is produced by Jean-Louis Chavy.
Aged in old French Oak barrels, this full bodied wine represents all the best attributes of the Chardonnay grape, having a charming aroma of honey and lemon with some toasty notes from the oak with a supporting, crisp acidity.

42. Chablis Gran Cru Valmur J Moreau Chablis, France / £87.50

Since a law was passed in 1938, 111 hectares of south/south-western facing vines that benefit from optimal exposure to the sun are entitled to bear the Chablis Grand Cru appellation. The 11.92 ha of Valmur stretch across a "valley" at the heart of the appellation. Green gold in colour, intense mineral scents with aromas of flowers and dried fruits lead to a charming and balanced palate. The jewel in the crown of the Chablis range.

43. Tyrell's Vineyard 'Johnno's Hand Pressed Semillon' Hunter Valley, Australia / £97.50

Established in 1885 by English immigrant Edward Tyrell, Tyrell's Wines is one of Australia's pre-eminent wine companies. The vines for this wine were originally planted in 1908, with this vintage picked on 3rd February 2010, then immediately hand pressed in an original basket press, racked and fermented, before being bottles on 9th July 2010. This wine is a soft style Semillon with a clean, fresh acidic structure, which lengthens the palate.

44. Mersault 1er Cru Genevrieres Bouchard Pere et Fils

Cote de Beaune, France / £115.00

Founded in 1731 in Beaune by Michel Bouchard, and now one of the oldest estates in Burgundy, with a tradition spreading 9 generations. Bright pale yellow, with lemon, spices and smoky minerality on the nose. Silky on entry, expanding to fill the mouth with rich, yet brisk flavours of lemon, dusty stone and vanilla oak. Good acidity and nicely balanced. The captivating finish shows a lightly, smoky quality and noteworthy finesse

45. Bodega Museum Real Reserva CigalesCigales, Spain / £55.00

This low yielding wine is made from vines over 70 years old. Aged for 24 months in new French oak and a further 12 months in the bottle before release. Ruby red in colour, with a delicate perfume of roasted spices, notes of liquorice and red fruits. The flavours are delicate, subtle and elegant in the mouth with rounded tannins and an expressive long finish.



Premium Reds

45. Gigondas, Domaine Raspail-Ay Rhone, France / £62.50

With a history of five generations since 1850, Dominique Ay produces wine that can be consumed from 3-4 up to 15-20 years, depending on vintages' and preference. The 2011 vintage gives signs of being a powerful wine with a lovely fruitiness and surprising sweetness, with great aging potential. A blend of 80% Grenache, 15% Syrah and 5% Mouvedre that is ripe and generous on the palate with notes of liquorice and black pepper. Rich and supple tannins support a long lasting finish.

46. St Emilion Grand cru, Chateau Puy Blanquet Bordeaux, France / £67.50

From the wine town of St. Emilion in the Libourmais district of Bordeaux, with strict vineyard yields to differentiate from standard wines of the region, the Grand Cru having been awarded in 1954. This wine offers flavours of dark, black plums, with an earthy background and moderate length. The tannins are firmly structured but rounded, with a lighter classic, slightly austere style.

47. San Marzano Primitivo Riserva 62 Anniversario

Puliga, Italy / £75.00

In 1962, the 19 vine growers from San Marzano, whose families had farmed the land for generations, combined their efforts to establish 'Cantine San Marzano'. This Primitivo is aged for 12 months in French and American oak barrels, which give an intense ruby colour and a complex nose, being fruity with prune and cherry jam aromas. Full bodies, with soft and rich tannins, with notes of cocoa, coffee and vanilla showing through.

48. Chateau Moulinet Lasserre Pomerol Bordeaux, France / £87.50

Pomerol is a much respected red wine region of Bordeaux that has earned itself a place amongst the world's most revered wine regions. This wine is deep red, with plum, chocolate and berry aromas, full bodied with firm tannins and a tight finish which expands with time to breathe and become very old style in drinking.

49. Vosne Romanee, Domaine Jacques Cacheux

Burgundy, France / £95.00

Midway between Dijon and Beaune, Vosne Romanee is one of the most famous French wine villages. This wine has a perfect balance of weight, structure and elegance so familiar to Pinot Noir, with a combination of red fruits, liquorice and smoke on the nose, having a long finish on the palate.

50. Tyrell's Vineyard Four Acres Shiraz Hunter Valley, Australia / £107

Headed up by the fourth generation family member Bruce Tyrell, Tyrell's now produce some of Australia's most awarded wines. The wine is bright purple in colour, with an exotic nose of red berries, confectionery and spices. Seamless on the palate, showing a lighter style can still be very complex with great fruit power. It has amazing length which is complemented by a good structure with soft and subtle tannins.

From The Americas

Welcome to the Virtuoso Collection.

These wines represent the best of their respective countries, the vineyards in which they are grown, and the grapes from which they are fashioned.

They are called Virtuoso because their production represents a wonderful synergy of craftsmanship and nature. Combining the aspect, the weather, the soil and the vines to make it possible, along with the skill and vision of the men and women winemakers of the collection which creates something unique.

The amazing progress of both North and South American winemaking is on display through the outstanding quality of wines within this range, a revelation!

Five wines, five vineyards, and five winemakers.

Together they make up the Virtuoso Collection: fine wines from the Americas.



Wirtuoso Red Wines

51. Bonterra, 'The Butler' Biodynamic California / C / £35.00

Bonterra's philosophy is captured in its strapline, 'The Natural Approach to Wine Making'. All Bonterra's wines are 100% certified organic and are produced from estate-owned vineyards. Perched between 1500 and 2200 feet above the McNab Ranch in mountainous Mendocino County, California, every block at Butler Ranch was built from scratch by vineyard director Dave Koball and lead winemaker Bob Blue, to showcase the distinct varietals that paired best with the qualities of each area. These vineyards were also designed as certified Biodynamic from the outset. The blend is predominantly Syrah, with the addition of Grenache, Mourvedre and Petit Syrah for added complexity. The resulting win is filled with aromas of ripe plum and dark cherries with a hint of violets.

52. Terrunyo Carménère Chile / D / £47.50

Terrunyo means 'Terroir' in Spanish and the wines which bear this name are made from very special blocks within Concha y Toro's meticulously mapped vineyards. Winemaker Ignacio Recabarren has identified which varieties would be best suited to the area, and only the best blocks are chosen for each Terrunyo varietal. The Peumo vineyard in Cachapoal's Block 27 has been singled out as producing the very finest Carménère in the entire Concha y Toro vineyard holdings. The grape variety, originally from Bordeaux but now a 'native' of Chile, when properly managed produces wines of real intensity, length and distinction.

53. Pinot Noir Cono Sur Ocio Chile / C / £67.50

Cono Sur's Estate wine and Chile's first ultra-premium Pinot Noir. Ocio derives from the word Otium, meaning leisure. It is that sacred and well-earned rest after life's stresses are taken care of and your spirit is free to grow, contemplate and create. Grapes for this wine are grown in El Triangulo Estate, Casablanca Valley where the soils are rich in minerals and red clay. The resulting wine is a beautiful and concentrated ruby red colour of high intensity. Complex and delicate black cherry fruit and white floral aromas with notes of violets, merging with sweet spiced oak and chocolate. This amazing pinot Noir has very soft tannins, a great structure and a rich, long finish.

54. Trivento Eolo, Malbec Argentina / E / £79.75

In ancient mythology, Eolo is 'the God of the Winds'. The Trivento winery is named after the three winds the Polar, Sudestada and the Zonda, which blow through the vineyards of Mendoza, shaping the seasons and the styles of the wines. Eolo is Trivento's tribute to the winds. The vines, an extraordinary 4-hectare parcel in the Lujan de Cuyo Estate, were planted in 1912 at an altitude of 910 meters above sea-level. Due to this elevated altitude, the vineyard benefits from significant drops in night-time temperature and freshening winds. These conditions are ideal for a long, slow ripening period. The shallow bunches, irrigated using age-old techniques of dykes and ditches that flood with water from the upper Mendoza River. The resultant colour and concentration in the wine is spectacular, being 100% Malbec.

55. Cabernet Sauvignon, Don Melcho Chile / E / £92.50

Names after the founder of Concha y Toro, Don Melchor, is the Estate Wine of Concha y Toro. It's the Puente Alto's position that makes it so special, located in the Upper Maipo Valley at the foothills of the Andes. The climatic conditions allow the winemaker to follow maturation levels closely and wait patiently for the tannins to truly ripen. This is a classic Puente Alto Cabernet Sauvignon, opulent and expressive red fruits give way to a leather and tobacco bouquet, while excellent concentration gives brilliant structure and balance. Firm tannins, a good degree of ripeness and an impressive and persistent length.
